## RE: Emergency Intermodal Surcharge (EIS)—Canada

Dear Valued Customer,

Concerning to severe shortage of haulage capacity as well as critical yard congestion, local trucking costs have been surged significantly in provinces of Ontario and Quebec. To continuously serve the business demands effectively, we would like to update our EIS as follows

Effective Date: November 14, 2022—date of dispatch

FCL: Dry and Reefer Containers, all commodities, import and export

CY Toronto, ON: USD400 per container CY Montreal, QC: USD300 per container

As per initial announcement, EIS is an additional surcharge, on top of our current CA trucking tariff. It is applicable for haulage move only, pick up or delivery.

Please note that we are monitoring market conditions thoroughly and working closely with our service providers to minimize the impact to cargo interest. We will adjust EIS levels and/or effective dates as conditions change.
